## We are now P2P!

P2P is short for Pastor to Pastor Training Networks. As we grow and look towards incorporation, it is apparent we need a brand that better reflects the mission and spirit of our movement. We feel that P2P captures the collegiality and practical nature of our training. It also empowers those we train to train others.

Early on we self-identified as the Global Network for Theological Training. As we grew we realized this name had several shortcomings. It was long and cumbersome. It also sounded like several other groups with similar ministries. It did not set us apart. It likewise carried an academic tone. It was intimidating. Most pastors feel inadequate theologically training fellow pastors in an academic context. Thus, it created psychological barriers to reproduction.

However, P2P is far less intimidating and presents as more peer to peer, or colleague to colleague. We have shared this new name with our partners and they love it. They feel it releases them to share the training they have received with fellow pastors in their countries.

## God is Moving Powerfully in Peru!

Last month we returned to the mountains of Peru and discovered that God has been working mightily since our last visit.

The Trip began with quite a scare as Rebecca Morris, who was travelling with her husband Alan, developed an extreme case of altitude sickness. We are all very thankful that Rebecca is recovering and doing well. Ed Nerio stepped in and taught our theology of God class in three locations.

The pastors in these three locations were very enthusiastic. Word is spreading and we discovered that Julio Rojas Flores has been teaching out classes in twelve additional locations in the Quechua language. A brother from one of these schools is now teaching our classes in Bolivia. We have our first known granddaughter school, which is a huge milestone for us.

Ed was approached during his visit by pastors and leaders serving in Argentina, Brazil, and several other South American countries. We will be beginning new schools in Cusco Peru in February. Cusco is an 18 hour drive from Ayacucho, our current base in Peru.

We are now coordinating with these leaders to respond to the various doors that God has opened. It seems that the Peruvian Andes has opened doors to much of South America. It is crazy how much need there is. We only pray that we can be both faithful and wise as we respond to overwhelming and obvious need for biblical training that exists in so many places.

## Hitting our stride in Central America and Open Doors in Africa

Central America has long been our primary base of operation. We have been training pastors, and training pastors to train pastors for several years. Last month I led a course to specifically to train others to start P2P schools. Over 20 attended the course in San Salvador: including 3 current seminary professors. We anticipate this will fuel our multiplication efforts in the region. I will be leading a similar seminar in Santa Barbara Honduras in July. At this point we have lost count of all of the daughter schools that are being started. We try to keep up with who is going where, but we hear of new locations all the time.

We are likewise being met in Africa with tremendous enthusiasm. We will be in Sierra Leone in November and are coordinating with leaders in Kenya to start schools in these countries. Leaders in both countries know the expectation to pass the school on to others. They are already identifying leaders and locations, which is amazing, since we have yet to teach our first course.

A leader known as Apostle Senneh replied in a Whatsapp thread started to discuss the school. The thread has over 100 posts from many pastors.

*“We are coming to be train, so in return we too will train other, I believe this the great commission of the lord Jesus Christ. I know after this training we are going to take land for Jesus as we move on with the training may God bless rev director lebbie and the team fro us may God bring them safe Amen”*

His response is typical of the spirit of the pastors in Sierra Leone. Please pray for P2P as we respond to needs all over the world. New countries are opening all the time. We need wisdom, discernment, strength, and grace as we continue to seek God and respond to what he is doing.
