Much Needed Relief

Although our mission does not typically involve relief, God has used the P2P network both here in the US and in Latin America to help feed over 35,000 meals to over 600 families. Many of the families we assisted were pastors and all of the families were in great need. When COVID initially hit many Latin countries, these countries did not have the infrastructure and means of distribution to get food to all those who needed it. Our partners, led by Ed Nerio in El Salvador and Luis Vega in Honduras, did all of the heavy lifting, both actually and figuratively. They were able to identify those in need and ensure assistance came on time to the right people. We are proud to have played a role in this wonderful effort.



Grounded But Not Idle

The worldwide Coronavirus pandemic is disrupting life and travel everywhere. We have been grounded since March. However, God is continuing to move through P2P. We have experienced many exciting developments that will only enhance our ministry once international travel opens again. The following are some of the highlights.

New school locations – We have 12 additional locations ready to begin once we are allowed to travel: 6 in Ecuador, 4 in Nicaragua, and 2 in Costa Rica. We are currently exploring new opportunities Argentina, Colombia, Guatemala, Cuba, and the Dominican Republic. Just the 12 additional schools will bring our total of active school locations from 23 to 35.



We have started online classes – We recently piloted a conference online with 38 pastors in El Salvador. The conference went very well, and we now have plans for more conferences as well entire courses being taught online. We will begin our *Theology of God* class online in August. We will teach this course over 4 consecutive Mondays.



US pastor training – Through our partnership with the *Georgia Baptist Mission Board*, we have begun training US pastors to teach in Latin America. On Thursday July 16, we hosted 6 pastors and leaders from West Central Georgia interested in teaching in Ecuador. This 4 hour seminar prepared them to begin teaching P2P classes. This was the first of many trainings that will be taught throughout Georgia in the coming months.

Accreditation – We have entered into an agreement with the Baptist Seminary in Buenos Aires, Argentina to begin our program in remote locations throughout Argentina. Those who complete the program will receive a Certificate of Pastoral Ministry from the seminary. It is our hope the seminary will be willing to offer this certificate in other countries as well.

New Partnerships – We are excited about the future possibilities through collaboration with Colin Denlea and Joe Wilson of *New Churches Now*. *New Churches Now* catalyzes church planting movements around the world. They currently work in 44 countries and have asked us to train pastors once movements are in place. I have been invited to travel to Cuba in the Fall explore working with a network of over 200 pastors.

P2P Prayer Needs

With everything that is going, we at P2P covet your prayers now more than ever. We are excited about many new partners and opportunities, yet we know that God must lead and empower us as we move forward.

- Please pray for the safety and well being of our partners and pastors in El Salvador, Honduras, Peru, Sierra Leone, and Belarus. Pray for God to open doors to return to these countries, so we can resume our teaching program stronger than ever.
- Pray for God to prepare the way for new opportunities for schools in Peru, Belarus, Ecuador, Guatemala, Nicaragua, Colombia, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, and Argentina.
- Pray for US pastors to respond to the call to teach pastors overseas.
- Pray specifically for a church or group of churches to take the lead for training in Cuba. Anyone interested can contact Gary Bulley for more information.
- Pray that we will have the support and resources we need to continue this work and meet the financial needs of the ministry. We have many wonderful opportunities and literally thousands more pastors to train. However, we cannot do so if we lack the financial resources.
- Pray for me as the Executive Director (Gary) to experience wisdom and favor as I attempt to lead this ministry forward during these uncertain times.
